ITEM	RULES AND REGULATIONS
10	<p style="text-align: center;">COMPUTATION OF MILEAGE</p> <p>(a) Except as otherwise provided herein, mileage will be computed from point of origin to point of destination by the shortest route and shall be ascertained by compilation of distances as shown in current Ohio Transportation Map issued by Ohio Department of Transportation.</p> <p>(b) From any point of origin to any point of destination not shown on the Map referred to above or when mileage is not shown on the Map between named points, the distance from or to the next more distant point that is shown shall apply.</p> <p>(c) When the shipper requests a longer route than the shortest route, the actual mileage over the longer route will apply.</p> <p>(d) When shipments move under special permits as required by or obtained from a Municipal, State, or Federal Agency or Commission, which specifies the route to be travelled by the motor vehicle, the mileage to be used will be the mileage via the route specified in the special permit.</p> <p>(e) In computing mileage fraction of a mile shall be considered as one mile.</p>
20	<p style="text-align: center;">DISTANCE OR MILEAGE COMMODITY RATES</p> <p>Distance or mileage commodity rates shown herein may be used only when no commodity rates (other than distance commodity rates) have been published to apply from and to the same points over the same route.</p>
30	<p style="text-align: center;">IMPRACTICABLE OPERATIONS</p> <p>In no case shall carrier be required to perform service at any location at which it is impracticable to operate equipment because of:</p> <p>(a) The condition of the roads, streets, driveways, alleys or approaches thereto.</p> <p>(b) Any riot, strike, picketing or other labor disturbances.</p> <p>(c) Inadequate preparation of location for delivery.</p>
40	<p style="text-align: center;">LIMITATION OF SIZE AND WEIGHT</p> <p>The obligation to accept articles for shipment shall be subject to capacity, type of vehicles, facilities, equipment, and to requirements of laws, or ordinances limiting or regulating the transportation of property or the use of vehicles or facilities.</p>
50	<p style="text-align: center;">PICK-UP AND DELIVERY SERVICE</p> <p>Rates named in this Tariff include pick-up and delivery service at all points within the limits of the cities, towns, or villages from, to or between which the rates apply.</p>
60	<p style="text-align: center;">RELEASED VALUATION</p> <p>Each shipment transported must be released to a value not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00). For greater liability the valuation must be declared by the shipper and an additional charge of seventy-five (.75¢) will be made for each one hundred (\$100.00) or fraction thereof of declared value in excess of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), which charge shall be in addition to all other applicable charges.</p>
