HOUSEHOLD MOVES

A) Residential

- 1) ***\$149.00 per hour per two movers and one truck when scheduled on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday ***
\$35.00 per additional mover on these days.
\$44.00 per additional truck on these days.
- 2) ***\$169.00 per hour per two movers and one truck when scheduled on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday***
\$35.00 per additional mover on these days.
\$54.00 per additional truck on these days.



B) Minimum Charge

A minimum of one hour's labor plus a travel fee will be charged for all moves of items greater than three items.

C) Travel Charge

- 1) A travel charge of \$119.00 will be added to all moves consisting of four or more pieces done within Franklin County.
- 2) Moves outside Franklin county will be assessed a travel fee based on their hourly rate and the company's estimate for drive time to the load site, and back to the terminal from the unload site.

D) Delivery Rates

- 1) For pickup and delivery of three items or less within Franklin county, the customer will be charged \$180.00.
- 2) Any move consisting of four or more items will be billed at residential hourly rates.

E) Binding estimates

- 1) In lieu of charging the rates set forth in A,B,C and D above, Nest Tenders Ltd./dba Two Men And A Truck may provide binding estimates for the transportation of household goods and as to any such binding estimate given, Nest Tenders Ltd./dba Two Men And A Truck certifies that it shall provide binding estimates for the transportation of household goods in this state.

STORAGE

A) Storage fees

- 1) \$100.00 per crate per month for every billing cycle thereafter. *
- 2) Storage fees will be prorated to reflect the actual number of days in storage.
- 3) Storage fees will be billed monthly by credit card.
- 4) Storage fees will be charged in advance of the billing period.

- 5) If the customer chooses to have a different carrier remove their goods from storage, the customer will be billed the appropriate labor charge per hour while their goods are inventoried and brought to the dock for loading.
- 6) A descriptive inventory will be prepared for each shipment being brought into storage. If a customer asks the company to retrieve a particular piece or number of pieces while their goods are in storage, they will be billed the appropriate labor charge per hour to do so.
- 7) Hourly rates for household moves will apply when moving shipments into or out of storage.
- 8) Oversized or odd shaped items, which are too large or impractical for storing in a crate, will be stored in a separate area and billed at \$50.00 per month.

B) Dock fees

- 1) A \$10.00 dock fee will be assessed for each item brought to our dock for delivery at a later date.
- 2) Storage fees equal to one crate per piece will be charged for all items not delivered within thirty days.


VALUATION COVERAGE

A) Depreciated Value

- 1) Customers choosing this coverage will be billed \$3.00 per thousand dollars of declared value.

B) Full Replacement Value

- 1) Customers choosing this coverage will be billed \$6.00 per thousand dollars of declared value.
