ITEM 50 CANCELLING ORIGINAL AND REVISED PAGES, EXCEPT TITLE PAGE

Unless otherwise provided, amendment of a page will be made by reprinting the page and showing a revision number. The revision numbers will be used in consecutive numerical order beginning with "1st Revised Page". A revised page cancels any uncanceled revised or original pages which bear the same page number.

EXAMPLE:

ITEM 100 COMMODITY DESCRIPTIONS

The description of property to which charges, rates, rules and regulations apply in this tariff or in tariffs governed by this tariff is that class of property under the following commodity descriptions:

1. "HOUSEHOLD GOODS" means personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling. This definition shall not be construed to include; (a) shipments exclusively moving from a factory or store or; (b) transportation and those associated services for an employee paid for by an employer pursuant to a contract with a carrier.
2. FURNITURE, FIXTURES, EQUIPMENT AND THE PROPERTY OF STORES, OFFICES, MUSEUMS, INSTITUTIONS, HOSPITALS, OR OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS when a part of the stock, equipment, or supply of such storage, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments. This description shall not be construed to include the stock-in-trade of any establishment, whether consignor or consignee, other than used furniture and used fixtures, except when stored as, and incident to, the removal of the establishment of a portion thereof, from one location to another.
3. ARTICLES, INCLUDING OBJECTS OF ART, DISPLAYS AND EXHIBITS, which because of their unusual nature or value, require the specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods. This description shall not be construed to include any article, whether crated or uncrated, which does not, because of its unusual nature or value, require the specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods.

RULES AND REGULATIONS****ITEM 110****DEFINITIONS**

The following general definitions will apply when such terms are used in this tariff. Where different definitions are provided for the same terms in connection with charges, rates, rules or other provisions, such definitions will take precedence.

"MINI" means a container of 12, 16 or 20 feet which can be placed at customer site for self loading.

"CONSUMER" means any person who is the consignor or consignee and who is identified as such on the Rental Agreement.

"HOLIDAY" means New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, Hanukah and Christmas Day. Holidays that fall on a Saturday or Sunday, shall be considered a holiday on the date observed nationally.

"LESSOR" means Carrier providing service.

"REASONABLE DISPATCH" means the performance of transportation on the dates or during the period of time agreed upon by the Lessor and the Tenant and shown on The Rental Agreement.

"RENTAL AGREEMENT" means the agreement entered into by Lessor and Tenant and shall be provided by Lessor to Tenant at time service is requested and must be duly executed prior to providing service.

"SHIPMENT" means property tendered by one Tenant, and accepted by the Lessor, at one place or origin and at one time, for one Tenant, at one site and covered by one Rental Agreement. The name of only one Lessor and one Tenant shall appear on one Rental Agreement, but the Rental Agreement may also specify the name of a party to notify of the arrival of the Mini at the site(s).

"SITE" means customers designated place or premises where Mini is to be placed.

"THE TARIFF" means this publication and revised pages hereto.

"TENANT" means Person(s) requesting service.

ITEM 120 ARTICLES LIABLE TO CAUSE DAMAGE

- (A) Carrier will not accept for shipment hazardous articles or property liable to impregnate or otherwise damage equipment or other property.
- (B) The carrier will not accept for shipment articles which cannot be taken from the premises without damage to the articles or the premises.

ITEM 130 APPLICATION OF TARIFF

This tariff applies on self storage units known as "Mini's", as defined in Item 110 of this tariff. These mini's will be delivered and/or picked up by Lessor at Tenants premises and will be self loaded by Tenants.

Lessor and Tenant will enter into a Rental Agreement which will be presented at time service is requested of Lessor.

ITEM 140 IMPRACTICABLE OPERATION

The carrier shall not be obligated to perform pick-up or delivery or render any service at a place or places from or to which it is impracticable to operate vehicles because of:

1. The condition of roads, streets, driveway, alleys or approaches thereto.
2. Inadequate loading or unloading facilities.
3. Any riot, strike, picketing or other labor disturbance.

ITEM 150 PERISHABLE ARTICLES OR ARTICLES OF EXTRAORDINARY VALUE

- A. The Lessor will not assume any liability whatsoever for perishable articles, or articles of extraordinary value, including: currency, money, credit cards, jewelry, watches, precious stones or articles of extra ordinary value including accounts, bills, deeds, evidence of debts, securities, notes, postage stamps, stamp collections, revenue stamps, letters, or packets of letters, articles of peculiarly inherent value, precious metals or articles manufactured therefrom.
- B. When perishable articles are included in a shipment, with or without the knowledge of the Lessor, responsibility for condition or flavor will not be assumed by the Lessor.
